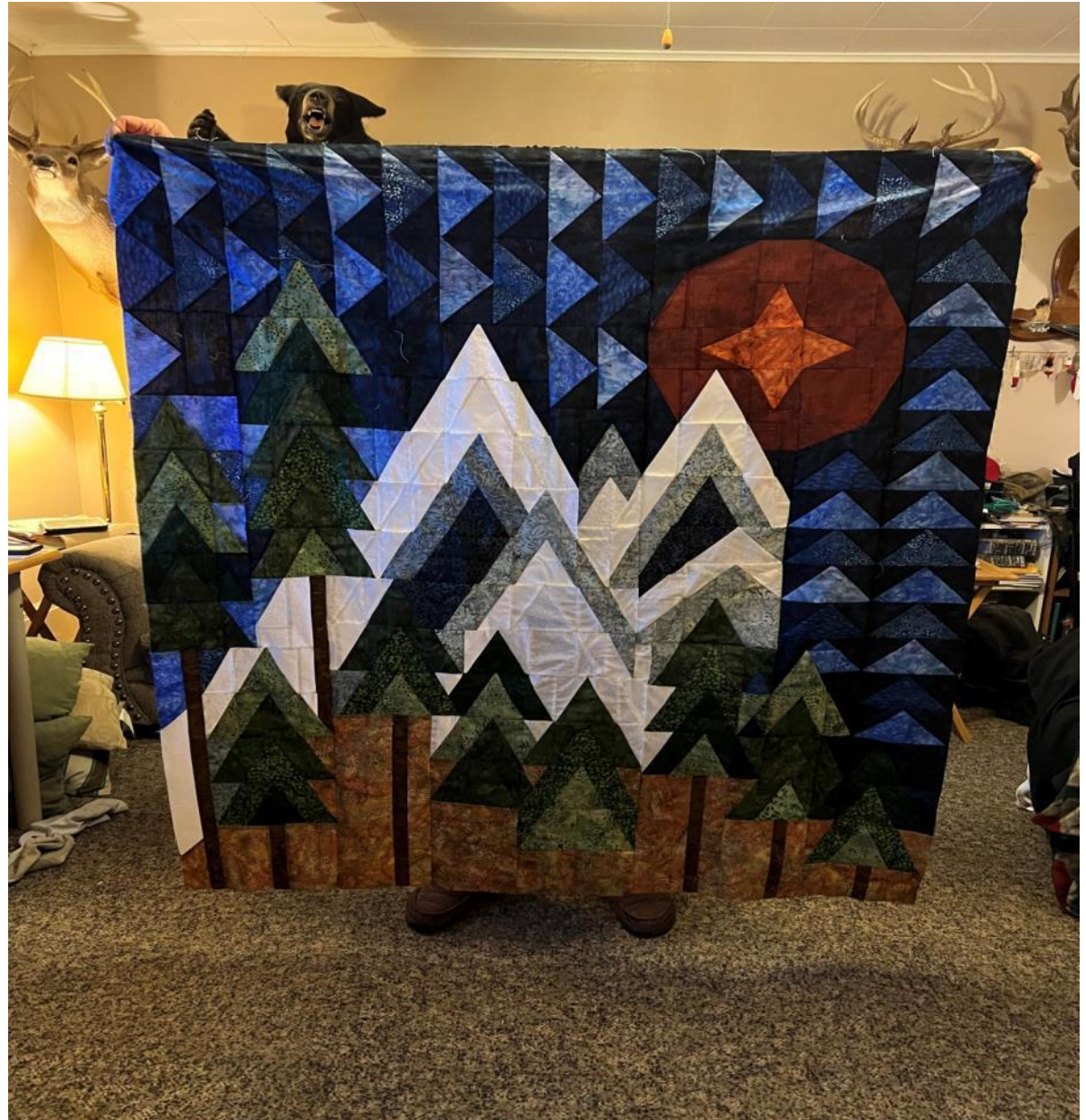


Chari Cure

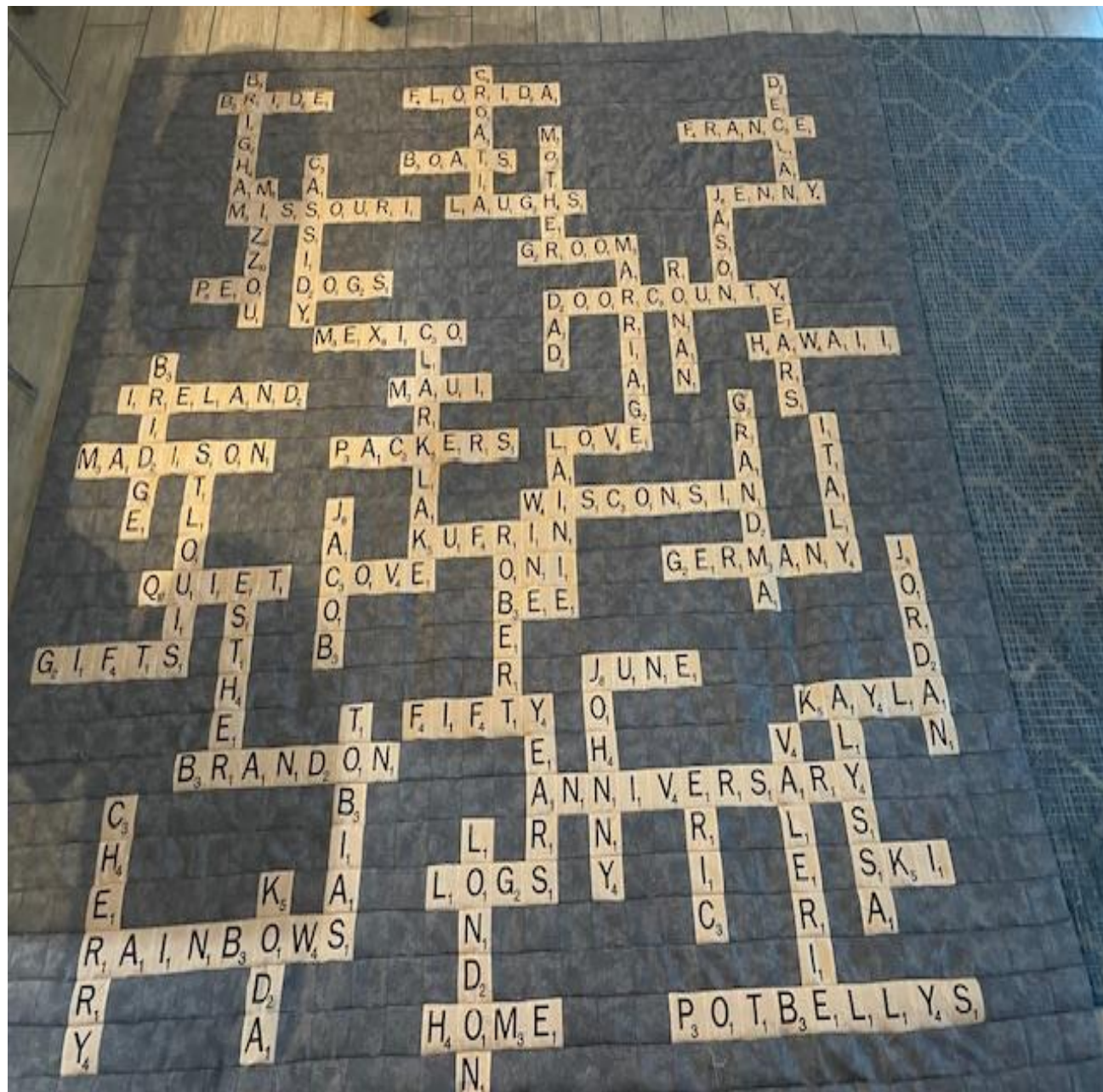
