Class name: Double Wedding Ring

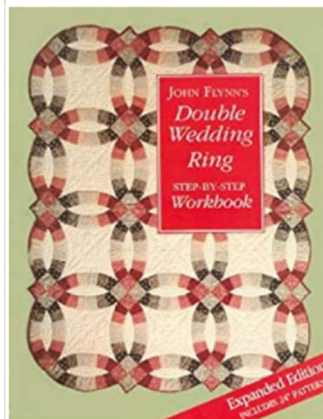
Description:

The Double Wedding Ring quilt pattern has long been a symbol of love and romance with its interlocking rings symbolizing marriage. It also can seem very daunting if you want to make one.

Nancy will teach you her techniques for piecing this quilt. Learning the step-by-step process this will give you the confidence to make one for yourself. In class you will work on a 4-ring quilt approximately 30" square. Once you understand the process you will be able to tackle a bed quilt size.

SUPPLY LIST

John Flynn Template set for an 18" Double Wedding Ring



FABRICS:

½ yard - Center and Melons – this can be your focus fabric that you can then pull the colors for your arches from.

¼ yard of 12 fabrics for the arches - Choose two color ways from your focus fabric and for each colorway you will need 6 fabrics (12 fabrics in total for both arches.)

1/8 yard of 2 fabrics for the center squares

BASIC SUPPLIES:

Rotary cutter, 28mm or 45mm size – no larger

Rotary mat: 18" x 24" recommended

Sewing machine in good working order – only bring a small “class” machine if you are very comfortable using it – I recommend you bring that machine you do most of your piecing on so you feel confident working with for this project.

100% Cotton 50 Weight piecing thread – neutral color

New Sewing machine needle – Size 70 Microtex for piecing

Straight pins – I recommend the Clover Silk glass ball head pins.

Spray Sizing – Mary Ellen’s Best Press or Magic by Faultless
