We have so many talented quilters, bag makers, and creators of art! Please contact the program director if you are willing to show your work to your quilting sisters at PPQG!



Blotto -- Amy's Quick Scrappy 9 Patch

Block Size: 12.5 inches unfinished

Cut 3 sets of (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch blocks of your scrappy fabrics.

#1-3 blocks in cream or white

#2-3 blocks in the different color

#3 - 3 blocks in a third color


Then assemble into the 9-patch block as pictured. Any questions, please email me <u>lckoziol2@gmail.com</u> or talk to me at a meeting. Due in August for the next block raffle

Blotto Rules and Procedures:

-All blocks must be turned in prior to the beginning of the night's meeting at designated entrance table.

-Members can enter up to 3 completed blocks. For the drawing, please turn in a piece of paper with the members name on it for each entry. A member will be able to win once per drawing.

-If you are unable to attend the meeting, blocks may be sent with a representative for the blotto night.



-Please use quality quilt fabric. (Not from Hobby Lobby, Jo Anne's or Michael's unless it's designated as quilt fabric.)

-First winner drawn gets first choice of a block grouping. The more people who participate, the more blocks and winners.

President's Block

It's that time of year again to start making your President's Block to present to the guild president to thank them for their hard work keeping the guild running smoothly. This year Val Howard has chosen a simple log cabin block. She would like it scrappy with traditional small prints. They can be presented to her any time between now and September. Please write your name in permanent ink on the front of the block so that she knows which block is yours! Thanks for all the work you have done for the Guild Val!

Block Directions

Pick your fabrics for the block with 1 side being the lighter colored fabrics and the other side being darker. The center square should be of a contrasting color. Cut 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ wide strips as shown in the diagram. Starting with the center square, sew them together in numerical order with a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Press and trim as you go. The final block should measure 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Around the Quilt Patch, May 2025

Light Fabric	Dark Fabric	Assembly
2.5 X 2.5	2.5 X 2.5	1. Cut out all the fabric from 2.5 inch strips.
4.5 X 2.5	4.5 X 2.5	2. Start with the Dark 2.5 inch square and the light 2.5
6.5 X 2.5	6.5 X 2.5	inch square and sew together.
8.5 X 2.5	8.5 X 2.5	3. Turn the block and add the light 4.5 X 2.5 strip
10.5 X 2.5	10.5 X 2.5	counter clockwise.
12.5 X 2.5	12.5 X 2.5	4. Continue adding strips in the order shown.
	14.5 X 2.5	5. Quilt block measures 14.5 square inches and finishes
		at 14 square inches.


