Class Supplies List

Class name:	Easy Sashings Quilt As You Go Workshop
Description:	For this class, you will bring any premade blocks that you want to use in a Quilt as You Go quilt. The size will be determined by you. In this class, we will work on 4-6 blocks with 1" finished sashings and cornerstones set on-point or a straight set. This is a workshop, which means everyone will be working on their own design with the teacher's supervision and instructions.

SUPPLY LIST

- Students will bring completed quilt blocks. I would recommend that they be 8" to 16"
- Fabric Requirements:
 - Depending on the size of your blocks, you will need backing fabric cut at least 2" larger than the blocks.
 - Cotton, Cotton Blend or Rayon batting cut into squares 2" larger than the blocks.
 - Quilt thread of your choice for the blocks and the backing. I highly recommend an invisible thread for the top or a coordinating 40 wt. thread for the top and a fine weight thread that is low contract in color to your chosen top thread. I like to use either BottomLine 60 wt. by Superior or Wonderfil Decobob or Invisafil for the bobbin thread. The teacher will bring a variety of threads for purchase (cash, check, or Venmo payment options)
 - At least one yard of fabric for the sashings. One yard for the front to coordinate with your blocks and one yard for the backing. For the backing, you may choose to use the same fabric that is on the backs of your quilts.
 - If you choose to work on a quilt on-point, you will also need to bring approximately 2 yards of fabric that coordinates with your blocks for the front of the quilt and 2 yards for the backing of the setting and corner triangles.
 - 1 yard for cornerstones that coordinate with your quilt top.

SUPPLIES:

The teacher will bring a small handout for the Easy Sashings technique, but she does have books to sell that use the technique with full color instructions.

- Rotary mat: Mat 18" x 24"
- Rotary cutter, 45mm or 60mm size
- Ruler – 6x24 (or larger) and a 12" or 15" square
- Sewing machine in good working order with a walking foot and/or a free motion foot
- 100% Cotton 50 Weight piecing thread for piecing sashings and cornerstones.
- New Sewing machine needle – Size 80 Microtex is best for this technique
- Straight pins – I recommend the Clover Silk glass ball head pins.
- Quilting gloves
- Roxanne's Baste-It glue
- Heat Press Batting Together ¾" wide - The teacher will bring some for purchase by the students.
- 505 basting spray – no other brand will work, it MUST be the 505 brand
